## The Cost of Everything is Going Up

Dear Constituent,

Inflation is soon expected to reach a 30-year high. Housing and gas prices are up by a third. Yet the Liberal economic plan makes no effort to address Canada's cost of living crisis and in fact increases government spending by \$71.2 billion.

Compounding this crisis is Trudeau's inflation tax - the fall economic update shows that government revenues have increased by \$15.6 billion due to rising inflation. This is eating into the paychecks of middle-class Canadians.

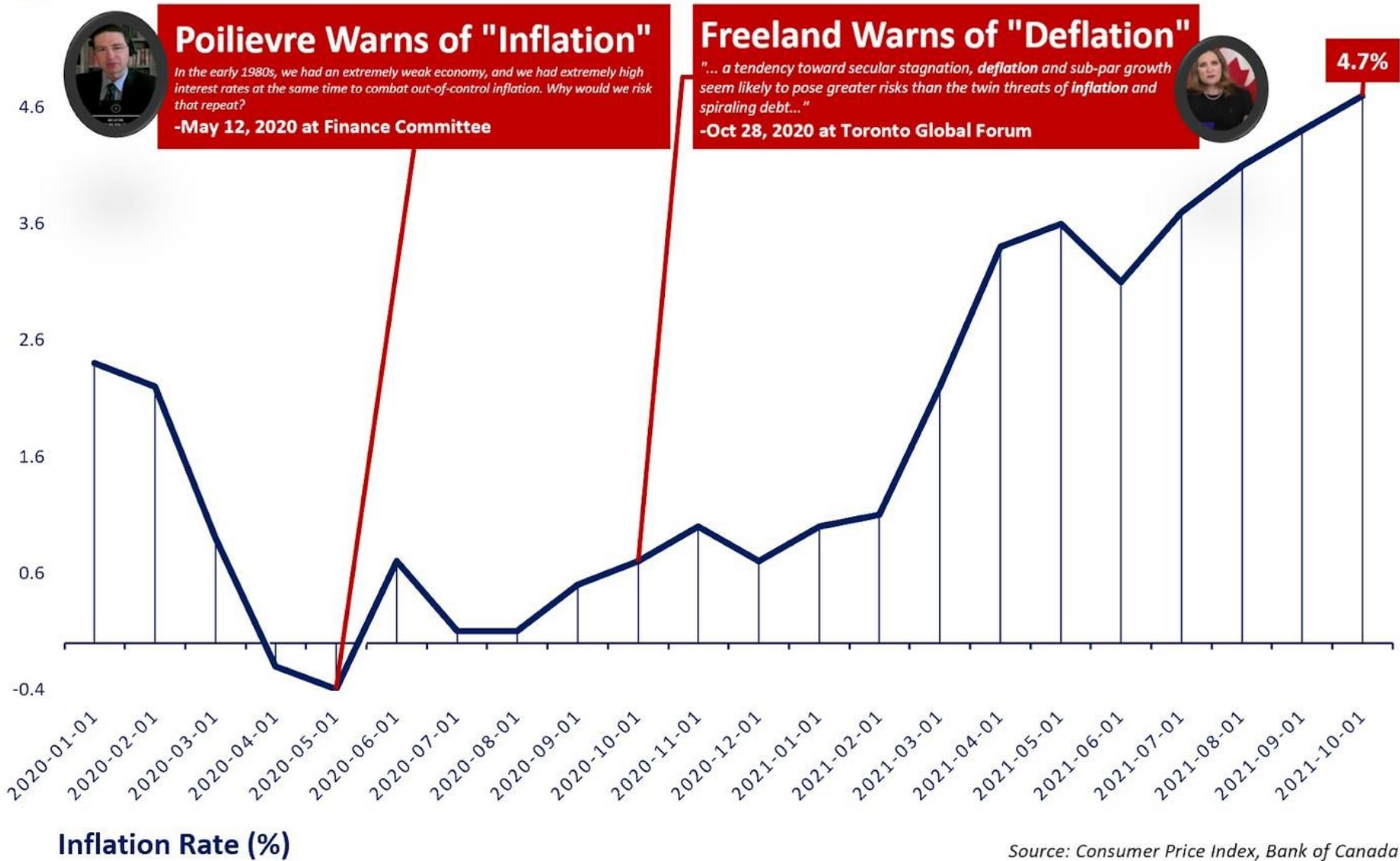

While the Liberals warn of “deflation,” Canadians are struggling to afford the rising costs of groceries.

The cost of living crisis is the number one concern facing families and seniors today:
