


# The Cost of Everything is Going Up

Dear Constituent,

Inflation is soon expected to reach a 30-year high. Housing and gas prices are up by a third. Yet the Liberal economic plan makes no effort to address Canada's cost of living crisis and in fact increases government spending by \$71.2 billion.


