

Petition to the House of Commons in Parliament Assembled

Petition to Pass Bill S-211

WHEREAS

- Modern slavery is deeply embedded in Canadian economic supply chains;
- More than 1,200 companies operating in Canada import goods that have been produced by child or forced labourers;
- Approximately \$20 billion (CAD) worth of goods at-risk of being produced through modern slavery are imported into Canada annually;
- Large companies are not required to report measures taken to prevent modern slavery in their supply chains;
- There are no provisions to prohibit the import of goods manufactured or produced, in whole or in part, by forced labour or child labour;
- Canada has committed to Target 8.7 of the 2030 United Nations Sustainable Development Goals to eliminate all forms of child labour by 2025.

We, the undersigned, citizens and residents of Canada, call upon the House of Commons to pass *Bill S-211, The Fighting Against Forced Labour and Child Labour in Supply Chains Act*.
