

PETITION TO THE HOUSE OF COMMONS

We, the undersigned citizens and residents of Canada, draw the attention of the House of Commons to the following:

Whereas:

- Hunting and firearm ownership play an integral role in Canadian history and culture;
- Many new Canadians love to participate in this heritage of hunting;
- Violent crime in Canada is up by 55% since 2015, with gun crime up 130% and extortion up 330%;
- The Public Safety Minister has admitted the \$742 million firearm buyback program will not make Canadians safer;
- The firearm buyback program targets law-abiding Canadians instead of stopping illegal firearms smuggled across the border, which is the real source of gun crime.

Therefore we, the undersigned citizens and residents of Canada, call upon the Government of Canada to:

- 1) Leave our firearms alone and defend the property rights of Canadian hunters;
- 2) End the government's wasteful buyback scheme that punishes law-abiding Canadians.
